Peel District School Board Honours 28 Students, Staff and Community Leaders at Annual Awards of Excellence

Mississauga, ON – May 9, 2025 - In celebration of Education Week, themed "<u>Igniting</u> <u>Minds, Inspiring Futures</u>," Peel District School Board proudly announced 28 award recipients for their exceptional contribution to public education across five key categories: Excellence in Community of Care; Excellence in Innovation in Education; Excellence in Sustainability in Education; Excellence in Equity in Education; and Excellence in Education.

This year's honourees include dedicated staff, visionary students, and passionate community members whose efforts are making a lasting difference in the lives of students and in the broader educational landscape.

Among the recipients is Loi Lam, Principal of Chinguacousy Secondary School, whose leadership and commitment to empowering staff and students has led to a notable increase in enrolment and a renewed sense of purpose within the school community. Also recognized are a group of four students from Harold M. Brathwaite Secondary School, who developed Questify, a groundbreaking app to personalize learning that impressed investors at a recent conference in Cambridge, where they successfully secured funding to expand their vision. And Irene Flemmings, a devoted advocate from the Bramalea area, received accolades for her endless support of students, particularly those new to Canada or facing financial hardship—a reminder that their community believes in their potential and is always there to support their journey.

In classrooms, worksites, and out in the community, these remarkable recipients are creating learning environments where every student feels valued, supported, and inspired."
